If you (or if your adult child) is planning to apply to teach in a Catholic School, it is highly recommended you contact the pastor one year before letter is written. Please plan to have a conversation with your pastor early in the process and you will avoid disappointment and stress at the time when applications are to be submitted.

Pastoral Letters of Reference - Candidate must contact the Pastor one year in advance before a character reference can be issued.

The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul is an international Catholic lay organization that serves the poor in 153 counties around the world including Canada. In the Toronto area, the Society does home visits to assist families with needs such as food, clothing, furniture, and also provides programs such as sports, summer camps, and other forms of support. In addition, the Society runs homes for people with varying needs in various locations around the city.

After meeting with Mother Teresa (now St. Teresa of Calcutta) a number of times in the late 1970's, a Toronto couple named Dr. Andrew Simone and his wife Joan, started a charitable organization called Canadian Food for Children in the early 1980's. Today the organization sends regular shipments of food, clothing, medicine, and other essentials to some of the poorest countries in the world. This work is done from a warehouse in Mississauga and is staffed with many volunteers, including young people from local schools.


