Planning to be a Catholic Teacher?

It is critical for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic school board in Ontario, as part of your application for employment there must be a letter of reference from your pastor. If you (or if your adult child) is planning to apply to teach in a Catholic School, it is highly recommended you contact the pastor one year before letter is written. Please plan to have a conversation with your pastor early in the process and you will avoid disappointment and stress at the time when applications are to be submitted.

Pastoral Letters of Reference - Candidate must contact the Pastor one year in advance before a character reference can be issued.

Mission Appeal

The Mission Office of our Archdiocese each year invites a missionary group to share about their mission work in all the parishes. The weekend of **July 6-7**, we will have guest speaker at all the masses offering the annual mission appeal for the church's many-faceted missionary activities throughout the world. Foundation for Children in Need is a Catholic lay organization based in Arlington Heights, IL. Dr. Geetha Yeruva, Founder and President of FCN is very happy to visit us and share about their mission work in the interior villages of India. FCN sponsors 2500 children and college students. They have been responsible for building several schools, boarding homes, a community health center and two homes for the elderly. They provide free medical check-ups and medicine to thousands of needy people and children. 800 children born with Cleft Lip and Cleft Palate are helped with free corrective surgeries in the past 5 years. We welcome Geetha and encourage you to support their mission work generously. There will be a second collection taken up next weekend. “Over the summer months, please remember the parish donation boxes located at the front and back of the church. Half of the proceeds will be given to The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul to provide food, clothing, furniture, and other forms of assistance (i.e. sports programs for children) for local families here in Etobicoke.

The other half of the proceeds will be given to Canadian Food for Children, founded by Dr. Andrew Simone and his wife Joan. Money donated is used to purchase non-perishable food, clothing, medicine and other essentials, as well as shipping costs. Large containers are sent every weekday to over 15 poor countries in the developing world, principally in Central and South America, Africa, Haiti and the Philippines. C.F.F.C. also sends containers to Rankin Inlet, an Inuit community in Canada's high Arctic.

By giving to our parish donation boxes at St. Gregory's, we are supporting our neighbor's in need both locally and around the world. In addition to providing needed material assistance, we are also giving our brothers and sisters dignity and love. God bless you and thank you for your generosity and consideration."
