What is World Day of the Poor?


The World Day of the Poor is a Roman Catholic observance, celebrated on the 33rd Sunday of Ordinary Time since 2017. It was establisted by Pope Francis in his Apostolic Letter, Misericordia et Misera, issued on 20 November 2016 to celebrate the end of the Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy. It is a day to reflect on poverty and who are the poor amongst us. This year, the fifth World Day of the Poor will be observed on 14 November 2021. Each year a theme is chosen in the message of His Holiness Pope Francis. This year's theme is, "The poor you will always have with you" (Mk 14:7)
