Feast of St. Blaise

Blessing of throats will take place after all the weekend Masses on Saturday, February 10 at 5pm, and on Sunday, February 11 at the 9am and 11am Masses.

The blessing, "Through the prayers of St. Blaise, may God free you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit" is given with two blessed, crossed candles at the throat. The story is told that St. Blaise saved a young boy who had a fish bone stuck in his throat; the candles commemorate the gift of two candles to light his prison cell before he was martyred for refusing to renounce his faith.

Marriage Sunday February 10/11, 2024


