

Cedar tea is said to have many health benefits, including antiinflammatory properties, respiratory support, and immune system boost. Cedar wood also has antioxidant and antibiotic properties. Benefits

Respiratory support: Cedar tea can help with bronchitis, pneumonia, chest colds, and the flu

Anti-inflammatory: Cedar tea can help with rheumatic symptoms and joint pain

Immune system boost: Cedar tea can help boost the body's immune system

Fevers: Cedar tea can help reduce the severity of fevers

> Air purification: Cedar tea can help purify indoor air Antiseptic: Cedar tea can help fight infections **Calming**: Cedar tea can have a comforting and

calming aroma

If you find the flavor of cedar tea overpowering, you can sweeten it with honey or maple syrup.

Excessive consumption can lead to toxicity due to the thujone content in cedar.

Certain individuals, such as pregnant and breastfeeding women, those with pre-existing medical conditions, or those on certain medications, should refrain from consuming cedar tea without prior consultation with a healthcare professional.
